Grayzel Seeks Investigation of Rosenbush/Sisler Campaign Violations --Deadlines Ignored on Campaign Contributions Report in Violation of NJ Election Law--

October 28, 2009—Morris Township Committee member Jeff Grayzel has called for an investigation into the Rosenbush/Sisler campaign's failure to file its reports on campaign contributions, as mandated by New Jersey election law.

The reports, known as R-1 reports, show all contributions a campaign has received to date, as well as expenditures made. Candidates running for office in the state are required to file these campaign finance reports 29 days and 11 days prior to Election Day, as well as a 20-day post-election report. The Rosenbush/Sisler campaign failed to file both its pre-11 day and pre-29 day reports, according to Grayzel, who has filed a request for an investigation with the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission. Violations of these reporting rules can result in monetary penalties.

Grayzel commented, "I can't speculate as to why Mr. Rosenbush and Mr. Sisler would not want their list of contributors released before the election. I do know that the law applies to all candidates. One would think that after being in office for 14 years, Rosenbush would know the rules—and he should not be allowed to pick and choose which laws to follow." Rosenbush and Sisler are running for Morris Township Committee, as are Jeff Grayzel and Mary Marley-Reidy.
